Secure Website & Privacy. A legitimate pharmacy uses secure, encrypted checkout and protects customer data. Check for HTTPS and privacy policies. FDA and Health Canada both advise to avoid sites that do not clearly safeguard your personal/financial information.

By following these guidelines – requiring valid prescriptions and professional oversight – you greatly reduce the risk of buying counterfeit or unsafe medicines. As the FDA puts it, safe online pharmacies always “require a doctor’s prescription,” list a U.S. address/phone, have a licensed pharmacist on staff, and are licensed by a state board.
